

**THE CORPORATION OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY**

**BY-LAW NO. 2002-52**

**BEING A BY-LAW PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF  
STOP SIGNS AT INTERSECTIONS IN THE  
VILLAGE OF EGANVILLE, IN THE  
TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY**

**WHEREAS**, Section 137, of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, provides that the Council of a municipality and the trustees of a police village may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction, and every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Township of Bonnechere Valley enacts as follows:

- 1) The intersections on streets set out in Column 1 are designated as Intersections where stop signs shall be erected at the location shown in Column 2.

**Column 1**  
**Intersection**

**Alice Street and  
James Street**

**Column 2**  
**Facing Traffic**

**Eastbound & Westbound  
on Alice Street**

- 2) The penalties provided in Section 214, of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, shall apply to any contravention of this by-law.
- 3) Each designation made by Section 1 of this by-law shall become effective upon the erection of the stop signs, in accordance with the regulation of the Highway Traffic Act.
