

Schedule "A"
to By-Law #2003-17

Household Hazardous Waste

The following are considered to be Household Hazardous Waste and will not be accepted at the Waste Site. They must be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot at the Ottawa Valley Waste Recovery Centre, 900 Woyto Station Rd., on such days designated for that purpose.

1. Batteries (all types)
2. Bleach
3. Drain Cleaner
4. Gasoline mixtures
5. Household cleaners
6. Medication
7. Oil
8. Paint
9. Paint solvents, turpentine, etc.
10. Pesticide and Herbicides
11. Propane and Gas Cylinders (other than those for cooking)
12. Used needles, lancets and syringes (must be placed in a sealed plastic bottles, clearly labeled as containing needles. Add some bleach to the bottle.)

Other Unacceptable Waste

1. Asphalt.
2. Biomedical wastes.
3. Carcasses or parts of any animal or fowl with the exception of bonafide kitchen waste.
4. Earth - contaminated with other than petroleum products.
5. Earth - rock.
6. Explosives or combustible material (other than Household Hazardous Waste Depot).
7. Hay or straw.
8. Hazardous and Toxic Waste (other than Household Hazardous Waste Depot).
9. Human or animal excrement.
10. Motor vehicles.
11. PCB related material.
12. Radioactive waste.
13. Raw or processed sewage
14. Unknown Waste
15. Waste from other landfill sites, former dumps and waste disposal areas except by special agreement and negotiated costs.
