

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY
BY-LAW NO. 2006-22**

BEING A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE
TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY FIRE DEPARTMENT
TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COUNTY OF RENFREW
MUTUAL AID PLAN

WHEREAS, The Municipal Act 2001, c.25, Section 20(1), as amended, provides that a municipality may enter into an agreement with one or more municipalities or local bodies, for their joint benefit, any matter which all of them have the power to provide within their own boundaries;

AND WHEREAS, the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, Chapter 4, Statutes of Ontario, 1997, authorize the councils of local municipalities to provide and/or receive fire protection services to or from other municipalities;

AND WHEREAS, the County of Renfrew established a Mutual Aid Plan;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley enacts as follows:

1. That the Bonnechere Valley Fire Department be authorized to leave the limits of the municipality, at the discretion of the Fire Chief or a fire department designate, to respond to calls from other fire departments authorized to participate in any County, Regional or District mutual aid plan established by a fire co-ordinator appointed by the Fire Marshal or any other similar reciprocal plan.
2. In case the provisions of this by-law conflict with the provisions of any other by-law, the provisions of this by-law shall prevail.
3. That this by-law comes into effect the day it is passed by Council.
