**BY-LAW NUMBER 2006-42**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW  
NUMBER 10-91, AS AMENDED, OF THE (FORMER) TOWNSHIP  
OF SOUTH ALGONA**

PURSUANT TO SECTION 34 OF THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** Zoning By-law Number 10-91, as amended, of the (former) Township of South Algona, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
  - (a) By adding the following a new subsection immediately following Section 4.3 (d) Exception Four (E4) Zone as follows:

“(e) Exception Five (E5) Zone:  
Notwithstanding the requirements of Section 3.10 and any other provision of this By-law No. 10-91, to the contrary, for those lands located in Part of Lot 25, Concession 10, in the geographic Township of South Algona, in the Township of Bonnechere Valley and more specifically described as Parts 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7, RP 49R-15942, and delineated as Exception Five (E5) on any Schedule A-5 (By-Law No. 10-91) of this By-law, a Limited Service Seasonal Dwelling shall be a permitted use.”
  - (b) By zoning certain lands located in Part of Lot 25, Concession 10, in the geographic Township of South Algona, in the Township of Bonnechere Valley and more specifically described as Parts 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7, RP 49R-15942 and shown on Schedule “A” attached hereto as Exception Five (E5) Zone.
  - (c) The zoning map schedule titled “This is Schedule “A-5 to By-law No. 10-91”, contained on Schedule “A” attached hereto, is hereby annexed to By-law No. 10-91 as Schedule “A-5 to By-law No. 10-91” and shall form part of said By-law”.
2. **THAT** save as aforesaid all other provisions of By-law Number 10-91, as amended, of the (former) Township of South Algona shall be complied with.
3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
4. That By-Law No. 2006-15, is hereby rescinded.
