APPOINT MUNICIPAL OFFICERS BY-LAW

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the Line Fences Act R.S.O 1990, c. L.17 states that The council of every local municipality shall by by-law appoint such number of fence-viewers as are required to carry out the provisions of this Act and the by-law shall fix the remuneration to be paid to the fence-viewers and the remuneration may be fixed on an hourly or daily rate or a rate for each attendance or re-attendance by the fence-viewers. R.S.O 1990, c. L.17, s. 2.

AND WHEREAS, The Livestock, Poultry and Honey Bee protection act R.S.O 1990, c. L.24, s. 4 (1) states that: (1) The council of every local municipality shall appoint one or more persons as valuers of Livestock and poultry for the purposes of this Act. R.S.O. 1990, c. L.24, s. 4 (1).

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley enacts as follows;
