

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY

BY-LAW 2008-60

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMITS FROM STATUTORY SPEED LIMITS FOR A PORTION OF A SPECIFIC HIGHWAYS

Whereas, Subsection (2) and (3) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8 as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality and trustees of a police village by by-law to prescribe a rate of speed of 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90 or 100 kilometers per hour for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under jurisdiction:

And Whereas, it is deemed expedient that the speed limit of motor vehicles on Buelow Road in the Township of Bonnechere Valley be restricted:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley enacts as follows:

1. When any highway or portion of highway as set out below is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall 25 kilometers per hour;

Highway
Buelow Rd. 131 Buelow Rd. to 195 Buelow Rd.

2. The penalties provided in Subsection 14 of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against the By-Law.
3. This By-Law shall come into effect on the date of final passing thereof.
4. Any By-Laws or sections thereof, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
